**REGLEMENTARY PERIODS AND CUT OFF DATES  
FOR DISTRICT IV, V, & IX, ELECTIONS ON  
June 20, June 27, & July 04, 2009**

**I. Article I Section 3**

**Date of Election**

*(Proposed Board Meeting Date)  
June 20 to July 4, 2009*

-It shall be the responsibility of the Board of Directors to call, schedule and provide appropriation for, by resolution, the regular conduct of district elections. Such resolution shall be passed in not less than 90 days nor more than 120 days before the annual meeting of the cooperative as provided for in the By laws. Copy of the Resolution shall be submitted to NEA, and also copy furnished to the Regional Electrification Center, within 2 weeks after the Board Meeting

**ARRA**

-**August 15, 2009** In not less than thirty (30) days, nor more than sixty (60) days before the annual meeting of the cooperative as provided for in the By laws, election shall be held for districts where the terms of office of the incumbent board members as fixed by the By-laws are due to expire. The thirty (30) days shall be reckoned from the date of the last elections scheduled for the year.

**II. Article VI Section 17**

**Cut-off Date for  
Qualified Voters**

**April 06, 2009**

**Board Meeting**

-Only the members of the cooperative whose application for membership has been approved by the Board not later than ninety (90) days before the first district election scheduled for a particular year shall be included in the master list of voters and shall have the right to vote.

**Section 18**

-The verification period shall not be more than twenty (20) nor less than ten (10) days before the election. (Inclusion / Exclusion Period)

- District V - June 17, 2009 (Wednesday)
- District IX - June 24, 2009 (Wednesday)

**III. Article I Section 6  
Notice of Regular  
Election**

-Written notices stating the purpose, place, date and time of the election and the deadline for the filing of Certificate of Candidacy shall be posted in strategic places within the voting district not less than twenty (20) days before the date of the election. The same written notice shall be delivered either personally or by mail to each member of the concerned DECOM. In addition, print and/or broadcast media may also be availed of, if necessary.

District IV - May 31, 2009 (Sunday)  
District V - June 07, 2009 (Sunday)  
District IX - June 14, 2009 (Sunday)

**Deadline for filing of Certificate of Candidacy in a District - 10 days before the District Election.**

District IV - June 10, 2009 (Wednesday)  
District V - June 17, 2009 (Wednesday)  
District IX - June 24, 2009 (Wednesday)

**IV. Article II Section 2  
Screening**

a. -In not less than seven (7) days before the election, the SC shall prepare the duly certified list of qualified candidates and officially inform all applicants accordingly.

b. -Protest arising from a *disqualification* shall be filed with the Screening Committee in not less than 5 days before the election. The SC shall decide the protest within 48 hours from receipt thereof. Failure of the applicant to file his/her protest within the above cited period shall be deemed a waiver of his/her right to protest.

**Protest (Post Election)**-To be filed in the office within 3 days after proclamation of the results of the election.

**Day of Election** -Delivery Disposal of elections paraphernalia/Ballot boxes shall be under the custody of the PECOMS/DECOMS/CPAG.

**Term of office for the Board of Directors** -3 years with 2 (Two) consecutive re-elections.

**Article VIII Section 27**

**District Election Committee** -The NEA/RE Center shall immediately appoint from among the nominees of the concerned cooperative, a District Election Committee to be composed of a Chairman, a Secretary and a third member not later than twenty (20) days before the election.
